



DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal: Adoption of the City’s 2015 periodic update to the Comprehensive Plan required by RCW 36.70A.130. As part of this amendment the City is expanding its Potential Annexation Area (PAA) to include one parcel that is currently in Tacoma’s PAA, but whose access is solely through properties under common ownership and located in Milton’s current PAA.

Proponent: City of Milton

Location of proposal, including street address, if any: The proposal will apply to the entire City of Milton including the Potential Annexation Area (PAA)

Lead agency: City of Milton (hereinafter, “the City”)

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment.
