DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSAL: **FFC Milton Landscape**
Create an upper and lower yard area with retention wall in between. Upper area will be a grass playfield of approximately 9000 SF. Lower area will be a secured fenced gravel area for storage. 8,350 sf of new imperious surface and 195 cy of fill.

PROPONENT: Faith Family Church

LOCATION OF PROPOSAL: 1702 Milton Way

LEAD AGENCY: City of Milton
